## **Purpose**

To build functional independence by teaching critical life skills, with a strong focus on safety and independence.

## **Core Target Area**

1. Laundry (sorting, machine use, folding, putting away)
2. Food skills, such as preparing smoothie, making a sandwich. (Snack prep, hygiene, simple sequencing, measuring/pouring liquids, appliance safety, following visual recipe)
3. Handwashing
4. Household routines (setting/clearing table, stacking/emptying dishwasher, washing dishes, drying dishes, cleaning, sweeping, etc)
5. Making a simple bed
6. Safety Skills (avoiding hot surfaces, knife safety, general safe/unsafe behaviours)

## **Admission Criteria**

Participants should:

- Tolerate a small group with structured support
- Have emerging communication (verbal or AAC)
- Be safe with supervision ratios provided
- Not require constant 1:1 for severe aggression or elopement (unless additional support is arranged)
